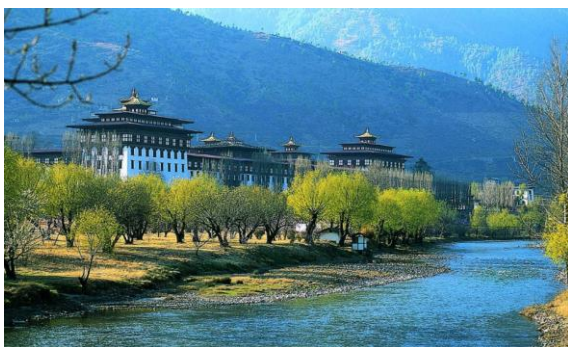
Arts and Crafts of Bhutan

Hand-woven textiles, Yatras or Yethras (colorful strips of wool cloth, dyed with natural colors, which are used to create blankets, jackets, bags and carpets), Buddhist paintings (usually made of cloth), many wood carved souvenirs.



Get Closer to Nature

Bhutan is a land of natural beauty. The **scenic beauty** of a stretch of green lush suddenly rising up steeply to form mountain is a relaxing sight for those who escaped from the concrete jungle. The place reflects its authenticity through the **green mountain** and passes. It is no wonder if you come across a beautiful rhododendron while your visit to spring. The rich flora and fauna are preserved safely in several **National Parks**. You are sure to come across some unique mammals and birds if you visit them.





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Go Trekking

Since Bhutan is located in **the lap of Himalaya**, Trekking is an inevitable activity which comprises physically challenging mountain highs and lows. A trek to **Zuri Dzong** is the most tempting activity allowing a bird's eye view to **Paro valley** with the magnificent green Himalaya in the backdrop.



Tourist Attractions

Thimphu has one of **the largest statues of Buddha** made of bronze and gilded in gold towering over Thimphu and the National Memorial Chorten nearby. Then there is the **Tiger's Nest (Taktsang)**, which is a beautiful monastery located in the cliff-side of the upper **Paro valley**. **Punakha Dzong, Zuri Dzong Hike, Gangtey Valley and Bumthang Valley** are some other breathtaking destinations in **Bhutan**.

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Tentative Itinerary

Day 1: Bagdogra Airport – Phuentsholing

After arriving to Bagdogra airport, we will leave for Phuentsholing (165km – 4hrs).
Overnight stay at Phuentsholing.

Day 2: Phuentsholing – Thimphu

After Breakfast we proceed to Thimphu (165km – 4.5hrs). Enroute we shall visit kharbandi, gumpha and crocodile farm. Overnight stay at Thimphu.

Day 3: Thimphu

After Breakfast orientation tour of Thimphu, where we will see SAARC Building, Buddha point, Handicraft Emporium, Tashichho Dzong and many more such places. Overnight stay at Thimphu.

Day 4: Thimphu – Punakha

After Breakfast there is free time to explore Thimphu and return for Lunch at Hotel. After Lunch we shall proceed towards Punakha (3hrs) and en-route enjoy water rafting (subject to operation).
Overnight stay at Punakha.

Day 5: Punakha – Paro

After Breakfast we shall visit punakha dzong, hanging bridge, talo and chimmy monestary. Later we will proceed towards Paro (3 hrs). Overnight stay at Paro.

Day 6: Paro

After Breakfast we shall visit Drukgyal Dzong and Rinpung Dzong and also enjoy the beautiful views of hiking mountain from its base. Later we will also visit the international airport, Museum and Tiger's Nest View. Overnight stay at Paro.

Day 7: Paro – Chele La Pass

After Breakfast we shall proceed towards Chele La Pass (45km – 1.5hrs). After exploring Chele La Pass and doing local sightseeing we return back to Paro. Overnight stay at Paro.

Day 8: Paro – Phuentsholing

After Breakfast you can explore Paro at your leisure. Later in the afternoon we shall leave for Phuentsholing (4hrs). Overnight stay at Phuentsholing.

Day 9: Phuentsholing – Bagdogra

After Breakfast we leave for Bagdogra airport (4hrs). Today our trip ends and we return back to our home or next destination with new experiences and memories to cherish.
