

Tentative Itinerary

Day 1: Cochin – Munnar

Start your journey from Cochin and proceed towards Munnar (4hrs). Overnight stay at Munnar.

Day 2: Munnar

After Breakfast visit Kundala Lake, Echo Point, Mattupetty Dam and Tata Tea Garden. Later in the evening visit Rose Garden and indulge in shopping at local market. Overnight stay at Munnar.

Day 3: Munnar

After Breakfast explore Munnar at your leisure and visit Rajamala Point and other spots. Overnight stay at Munnar.

Day 4: Munnar - Thekkady

After Breakfast we will proceed towards Thekkady (4hrs). Later we will visit Spice Garden and indulge in shopping at local market. Overnight stay at Thekkady.

Day 5: Thekkady - Kumarakom

Today early morning we leave for Periyar Lake where will enjoy the wildlife watching through boat. In afternoon we will leave for Kumarakom. Overnight stay at Kumarakom

Day 6: Kumarakom

After Breakfast relax and enjoy the backwater ride. Later proceed towards Alleppey Beach (1.5hrs) and visit Jain Temple and world-famous Popy Umbrella. Overnight stay at Kumarakom.

Day 7: Kumarakom – Kovalam

After Breakfast proceed towards Kovalam (6hrs) and visit Poovar Beach and Trivandrum local sightseeing. Overnight stay at Kovalam.

Day 8: Kovalam – Kanyakumari

After Breakfast we will visit Padmanabhapuram Palace (Monday Closed), Thanumalayan Temple, Janardhan Swami Temple and Cliff View Point. Later we will proceed towards Kanyakumari (1.5hrs) and enjoy the beautiful views of sunset and also visit Swami Vivekanand Rock Memorial. Overnight stay at Kovalam.

Day 9: Kovalam - Trivandrum

After Breakfast we will leave for Trivandrum Airport (1hr). Today our trip ends and we return back to our home or next destination with new experiences and memories to cherish.
