Tentative Itinerary

Day 1: Delhi – Sattal (Nainital)

In the morning we leave for Sattal from Delhi (330km – 9hrs). Overnight stay at Sattal.

Day 2: Sattal (Nainital)

After Breakfast visit Cave Garden, Nainital Zoo, Hanuman Dham and nearby sightseeing spots. Overnight stay at Sattal.

Day 3: Sattal (Nainital)

After Breakfast we will visit the lakes of Nainital such as Sattal, Naukuchiatal, Bhimtal and engage in different boat and other water activities. Later we will visit Hanuman Garhi Temple, Bhotia Market. Naini Devi Temple and Naini Lake. Overnight stay at Sattal

Day 4: Nainital – Corbett

After Breakfast we will proceed towards Corbett (175km - 4hrs). En-route we shall sightseeing Almora. Overnight stay at Corbett

Day 5: Corbett

Today early morning we will visit Jim Corbett National Park and enjoy the jeep safari. Later after breakfast free time to spend at your leisure. Later in afternoon we will go for sightseeing in Ranikhet. Overnight stay at Corbett

Day 6: Corbett – Haridwar

After Breakfast we will proceed towards Haridwar (100km – 3hrs). Later time to explore Haridwar and visit Ganaghat and attend the spiritual and magnificent Ganga Aarti. Overnight stay at Haridwar.

Day 7: Haridwar – Mussoorie

After Breakfast we will proceed towards Mussoorie (83km – 3hrs). En route we will visit Rishikesh and engage in some adventures such as water rafting, para-gliding, bungee jumping and other activities. Overnight stay at Mussoorie.

Day 8: Mussoorie

After Breakfast we will visit Kempty falls, Company garden, Lal Tibba, Gun Hill, Dehradun Zoo and other sightseeing spots and indulge in shopping at Mall Road. Overnight stay at Mussoorie.

Day 9: Mussoorie

After Breakfast we will proceed towards Delhi (230km – 6hrs). Today our trip ends and we return back to our home or next destination with new experiences and memories to cherish.
